The NHSS recognizes Club members who truly excel in the study of history. Only 4.9% of NHC members were inducted into the National History Scholars Society at the end of the 2016-2017 school year. The following requirements must be met and maintained:

- * B or higher GPA in Honors or AP History courses (at least one course).
- * Two or more years of active involvement in History Club. This must be at the same school.
 - * Recommendation by Advisor based on level of service to History Club.

All dues paying Chapters will receive burgundy honor cords to present to their inductees to wear at graduation (moderate fee per cord, free shipping). All Advisors will be notified by the National Office in the Spring to begin the process of submitting students for induction. Advisors must email a list of all students, along with the Honors or AP History courses that each student was enrolled in during his/her academic career. Cords will be shipped by Priority Mail to the Advisor, and should arrive within one week.
